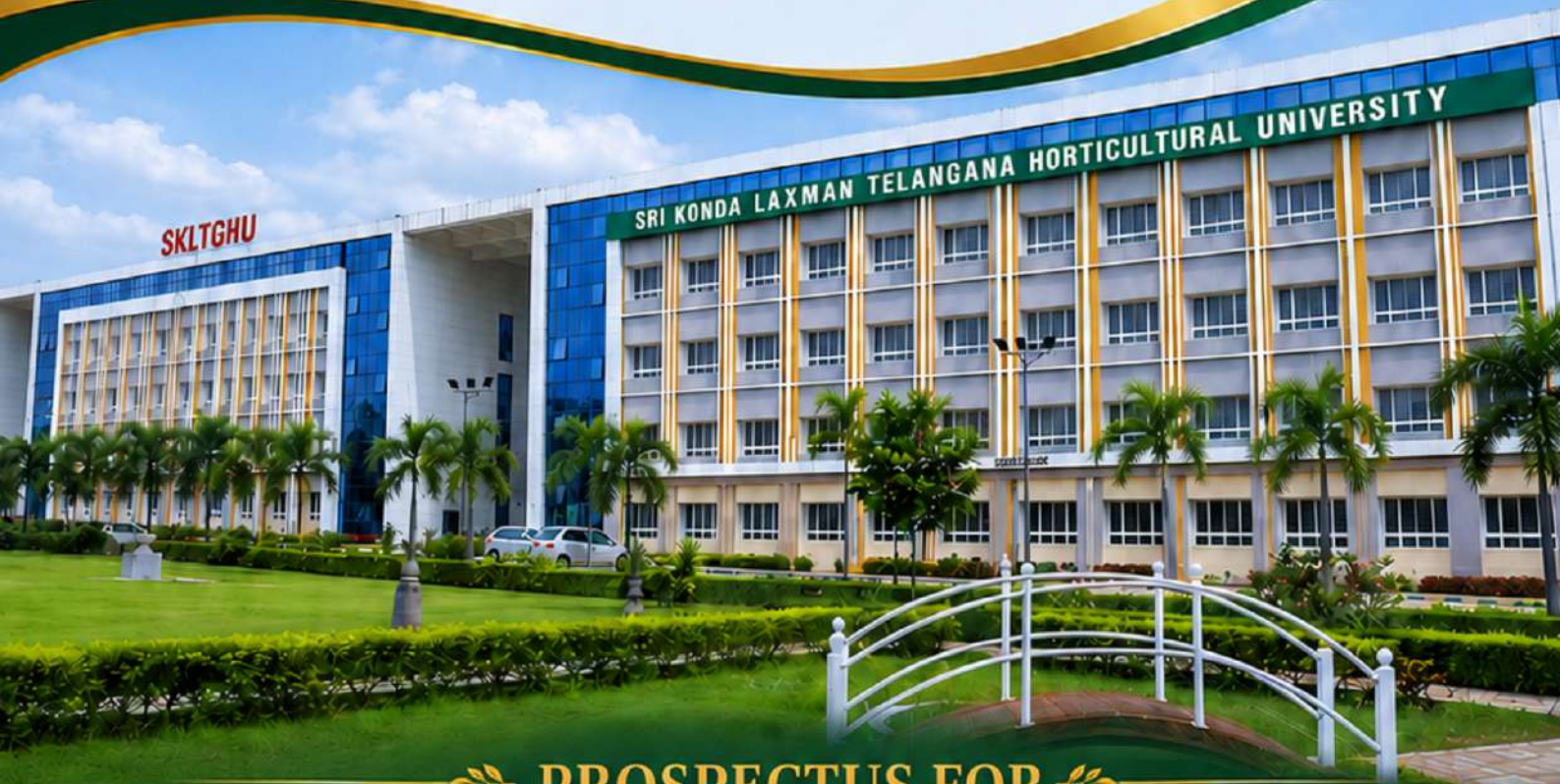

* Apart from the 284 seats, an additional 6 seats are available under the NRI quota at the College of Horticulture, Rajendranagar. These seats will be filled separately by Sri Konda Laxman Telangana Horticultural University. Candidates are therefore advised to visit the [University website](#) for further details.

I. Eligibility:

Candidates should have passed the two-year Intermediate Examination conducted by the Board of Intermediate Education, Telangana, or any other examination recognized as equivalent by the University or the Intermediate Board, with the following subjects:

1. Physical Sciences
2. Biological Sciences

II. Criteria for selection:

- Selection of candidates for all seats, including Self Finance Quota seats in the B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture programme, shall be based on the ranks secured in Telangana EAPCET–2026 conducted by the Telangana Council of Higher Education.
- In the event of a tie between two or more candidates in Telangana EAPCET–2026 ranks, the marks obtained in the optional subjects of the qualifying examination (Intermediate or its equivalent) shall be considered for determining merit. If the tie still persists, preference shall be given to the candidate who is older in age.

III. Age:

- Candidates seeking admission into the B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture programme must have completed 17 years of age. The upper age limit shall be 22 years for general candidates, 25 years for SC and ST candidates, and 27 years for Physically Challenged candidates. candidates as on **31st December of the year of admission.**

IV. Reservation of the seats:

The rule of reservation (OC:46%, EWS;10%, BC-A:7%, BC-B;10%, BC-C:1%, BC-D:7%, BC-E:4%, SC-Group-I:1%, SC- Group-II:9%, SC- Group-III:5%, ST:10%) will be followed as per the rules *(The rule of reservation will apply according to the latest guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana).*

- ❖ **Reservation of seats for candidates belonging to agriculturist families from rural areas (Farmers' Quota) in the B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture programme under both Regular and Self Finance Quotas.**
- ✓ Forty per cent (40%) of the seats are reserved for candidates belonging to agriculturist (farmer) families who have studied for a minimum period of four years in schools situated in Non-Municipal areas during their education from 1st Class to 12th Class/Intermediate and whose parents or the candidate own not less than one acre of agricultural land.

The eligibility criteria and documents to be submitted for claiming the seats under Farmer's, quotas are as follows:

✓ **ANNEXURE-I:** This proforma shall be certified by the Headmaster/Head of the Institution with the official seal, confirming that the candidate has studied for a minimum of four years in schools located in Non-Municipal areas during the period from 1st Class to 12th Class/Intermediate (Non-Municipal Area Certificate).

✓ **ANNEXURE-II:** This proforma shall contain the patta numbers and extent of agricultural land owned by the candidate/parents, duly certified by the Tahsildar with official seal. Alternatively, the candidate may upload attested photocopies of the Pattadar Pass Book as proof of land ownership and extent

✓ **ANNEXURE-I and ANNEXURE-II** must be duly completed and signed by the respective authorities, namely the Head of the Institution(s) and the Tahsildar, along with their official seals. Incomplete or uncertified documents will result in rejection of the candidate's claim under this category.

❖ **Reservation of seats under Special Categories:**

The counselling for seats under the Physically Challenged (PH-5%), Children of Armed Personnel (CAP-2%), National Cadet Corps (NCC-1%), and Sports (0.5%) quotas shall be conducted in the presence of the respective departmental officers. The certificates submitted by candidates belonging to these special categories will be verified by the concerned officers, and seat allotment shall be made based on the priorities determined by them. The University shall have no role in deciding or altering such priorities

a. Reservation under Physically Challenged Quota:

In various UG courses offered by SKLTGHU, 5% of seats are reserved for Physically Challenged or differently abled candidates. The candidates seeking reservation under above quota shall be required to be present himself/herself before a Selection Committee comprising of Residential Medical Officer, Specialists in the concerned fields of medicine and Deans of Faculty, who shall examine the suitability of the candidates to the various courses. As a part of the selection process, the candidates seeking admission into various UG courses of SKLTGHU shall be required to perform the activities such as identification of slides through microscopes, operation of push/wheel hoes and walking on the bunds, spraying with knapsack/power sprayer, weeding & digging, irrigating the fields, reading from the blackboard, writing, threading the needle, hearing tests etc.,

b. Reservation under Sports Quota:

As per G.O.Ms. No. 2 issued by the Government of Telangana dated 22-09-2020, 0.5% of the seats are reserved under the Sports Quota. The said G.O. specifies a total of 31 sports disciplines

eligible under this quota. Candidates seeking admission into various Undergraduate courses offered by Sri Konda Laxman Telangana Horticultural University under the Sports Quota must upload copies of their sports achievements/testimonials along with duly certified/attested **Forms I, II, III, and IV** (whichever are applicable) issued by the concerned State Sports Associations recognized by SATS, as per the category and level of championships participated in. Submission of the relevant **Forms I, II, III, and IV** is mandatory; failing which, the candidate shall not be considered under the Sports Quota. These forms are also available in the Online Admission Application Form.

a. Form I	For the International Championships (Medal & Participation) issued by the Federation
b. Form II	For Association National competitions (National/South Zone Medals/Participation and State Medals issued by the State Association
c. Form III	For the Universities Championships (Inter collegiate, South Zone University, All India/ World Universities issued by the Universities)
d. Form IV	For SGF, Central Government schemes, for all remaining events like World/Asian school games, National / State level / Inter District games issued by the DEO / DYSO/Secy.SGF/ SATS official

The scrutiny of sports applications, along with Forms I, II, III, and IV (wherever applicable), shall be carried out by the competent authority and thereafter examined by an evaluation committee for finalization of priorities for seat allotment.

❖ **Reservation of seats for Women:**

- In each course, 33 $\frac{1}{3}$ % of the seats shall be horizontally reserved in favour of women candidates from each category.

V. Allocation of seats:

- Of the total seats, 85% of the seats are reserved for local candidates, and 15% of seats are unreserved.

In this regard, as per the G.O. Ms. No. 15 of the Higher Education (TE) Department, Dated: 27-02-2025, the reservation of seats is as follows:

Admission to 85% of the seats shall be reserved in each course in the Educational Institutions in the State for local candidates of OU area as specified in the Andhra Pradesh Educational Institutions (Regulations and Admissions) Order, 1974 as subsequently amended and the remaining 15% of the seats shall be un-reserved seats to the following:

- a. All the candidates are eligible to be declared as local candidates of the O.U. area.

- b. Candidates who have resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of study outside the State, or either of whose parents has resided in the State for a total period of ten years, excluding periods of employment outside the State;
- c. Candidates who are children of parents who are in the employment of this State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities, and other similar quasi-public institutions within the State; and
- d. Candidates who are spouses of those in the employment of the State or Central Government, Public Sector Corporations, Local Bodies, Universities and educational institutions recognized by the Government or a University or other competent authority, and similar other quasi-Government institutions within the State.

Note: *The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations for 15% of seats under the Unreserved quota.*

VI. Residential Certificate:

- ✓ Applicants who have a gap or break in their studies for reasons other than failure, or those who have passed the qualifying examination through private study, must submit a certificate issued by the Tahsildar. If the applicant has resided in more than one place during the relevant period, separate certificates from the respective Tahsildars of those places of residence must be furnished.

VII. Hostel facility:

- Hostel facility shall be provided subject to the availability of accommodation in the respective colleges.

VIII. Original certificates to be produced at the time of counselling:

- SSC Memorandum of Marks or Equivalent Examination Certificate, showing the evidence of the Date of Birth.
- Pass Certificate cum Memorandum of Marks obtained by the applicant in the qualifying examination (Intermediate (10+2) or its Equivalent Examination).
- Telangana EAPCET-2026 Rank Card.
- Bonafide / Study Certificate from 1st to 12th Class.
- Transfer Certificate of the institute last studied.
- Residence certificate of Telangana.
- The certified copy of the Social Status Certificate issued by the competent authority of Telangana in case of applicants belonging to Backward Classes, Scheduled Castes, and Scheduled Tribes.
- The latest certified copy of the **EWS Certificate valid for the year 2026-27** issued by the competent authority in case of applicants belonging to the EWS category.

- Non-Municipal Area Study Certificate (ANNEXURE-I), if applicable.
- Agricultural Land Holding Certificate (ANNEXURE-II), if applicable.
- Legal heir certificate, if applicable.
- The certified copy of Physically Challenged Certificate, if applicable.
- Children of Armed Personnel Certificate / Defence Personnel Certificate, if applicable.
- National Cadet Corps (NCC) Certificate, if applicable.
- Sports and Games Certificates along with Form I, II, III & IV (whichever is applicable), which are mandatory for claiming a seat under the Sports quota, if applicable.

* The Lab/Library/Hostel/Mess deposits (refundable), mess & hostel charges are additional.

Note:

- The candidate who secures a seat (Regular/Self Finance quota) ***shall submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees (in cash)*** at the time of counselling itself.
- The seats pertaining to Self Finance Quota shall be filled based on ranks obtained by the candidates in the Telangana EAPCET-2026 and the rule of reservation.
- The rules and regulations with regard to eligibility, age, reservations, etc., are the same for the Self Finance quota that apply to the candidates admitted under the general quota.
- The candidates selected under the Self Finance quota shall be treated on par with regular students. No special amenities or facilities shall be provided.
- ***The Self Finance quota seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture shall be filled by separate counselling after filling up of regular seats.***
- The unfilled seats under the Self Finance quota shall not be filled from any other stream and shall be kept vacant.
- ***The candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fees or educational concessions offered by the Government.***

X. Other information:

- ***The guidelines issued by the Government of Telangana from time to time shall be followed scrupulously, including the reservations.***
- The University shall send SMS to the applicants for the purposes related to counselling. Hence, the candidates are informed to **mention their personal mobile numbers but not the mobile numbers of relatives, friends, net/online/Xerox centers, etc.**
- 20% of seats in B.Sc. (Hons.) Horticulture under ICAR quota shall be filled up by ICAR through the online counselling based on ranks obtained in CUET (UG) ICAR 2026 examination conducted at the national level.
- In the event of the establishment of new colleges, such seats shall also be considered for filling up through this notification only.
- The Counselling/Verification under special categories (PH, CAP, NCC & SPORTS) shall be held in the presence of the authorities concerned, and seats shall be allotted as per the priorities indicated by the officers concerned.
- ***If the admitted candidate cancels/withdraws his/her seat before the closure of admission process, the entire fee collected from the student shall be refunded in full after deducting Rs. 2,000/- (@ Rs. 5,000/- for Self Finance quota) as processing fee.***
- ***Any cancellation/withdrawal of admissions after the closure of the admission process, the candidate shall forfeit the entire fees (except the caution deposits). In addition, the candidate has to pay Rs. 2,000/- (@ Rs. 5,000/- for Self Finance quota) as processing fee.***

- The candidate who secures a seat should submit the certificates in Original along with the prescribed fees (in cash) at the time of counselling itself.
- During the counselling process, the seat availability position shall be updated at the end of the day and hosted on the University's website - www.skltgghu.ac.in. **The candidates are requested to go through the above information hosted on the website and accordingly attend the counselling.** No separate communication shall be sent in this regard.
- The University does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- The applicant is informed that mere submission of an online application and attending counselling do not guarantee the allotment of a seat.
- Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
- Sri Konda Laxman Telangana Horticultural University (SKLTGHU) is the only Horticultural University in the State. The University has not accorded any affiliation to any private colleges in Telangana.
- Registrar of the SKLTGHU is responsible for the information furnished in the prospectus related to the course.
- The University is not responsible for the information provided on other websites.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University, and as such, they are requested not to rely on any middlemen/persons/consultants who try to mislead the students in securing admission into SKLTGHU under any quota.
- All the regular and self finance quota seats shall be filled through the combined counselling only.
- In case the information furnished or the certificates uploaded by the candidates are found to be false, the University shall take appropriate action against the individuals concerned, and his/her application shall be summarily rejected.
